Student Completion Rate Report

As an institution offering financial aid programs to students, Northwestern Technological Institute provides students with completion rate information on an annual basis.

Reporting Period/Completion Rate

For the purpose of this report, Northwestern Technological Institute is required to provide student completion information for a cohort of students for which 150% of the normal time for completion elapsed between September 1, 2014 and August 31, 2015. The first class start where 150% completion time elapsed after September 1, 2014 was the May 15, 2013 class. This class graduated on April 1, 2014 and 150% completion time elapsed as of September 4, 2014. The last class start where 150% completion time elapsed before August 31, 2015 was the May 7, 2014 class. This class graduated on March 24, 2015 and 150% completion time elapsed as of August 27, 2015. For these classes, there were a total of 396 first-time students who entered the Climate Control Technology (CCT) program. Of the 396 students who entered the CCT program, 228, or 58% completed the program.
